

Roanoke Rapids Fact Check

FACT: Perdue misrepresents Moore's role. Local officials in Roanoke Rapids negotiated the contract with Randy Parton, not State Treasurer Richard Moore.

FACT: Perdue misrepresents the role of the Local Government Commission. The LGC's role in approving local debt is to assess the locality's ability to pay for the bonds, not to second guess how local elected officials use the proceeds or to micro-manage projects.

FACT: Perdue supported Amendment One and local control of similar projects like the one in Kannapolis.

FACT: Perdue has hidden her role in manufacturing this controversy. The letter referenced in the Perdue attack is actually from Perdue supporter and donor Allen Joines.

FACT: A Perdue donor is at the center of the controversy. If anyone should be checking their donor lists, it's Perdue. It turns out Bev Perdue supporter and donor Rick Watson is actually at the center the Roanoke Rapids problems with Randy Parton.
