NC GOP'S NATIONAL COMMITTEEWOMAN LINDA SHAW APPOINTED TO RNC 2008 CONVENTION COMMITTEE

Committee on Arrangements (COA) plans and manages the Republican National Convention

RALEIGH – Mike Duncan, Chairman, Republican National Committee recently appointed Linda Shaw, North Carolina's National Committeewoman to serve on the Committee of Arrangements (COA). The COA is the RNC committee tasked with the planning and management of the 2008 Republican National Convention. Ms. Shaw will serve on the committee with COA Chairman, Jo Ann Davidson, RNC Co-Chairman and National Committeewomen for Ohio. The 2008 Republican National Convention will be hosted by the twin cities of Minneapolis-Saint Paul from September 1 - 4, 2008. Ms. Shaw was also recently appointed by Mr. Duncan to the RNC Budget Committee.

Ms. Shaw has been a member of the North Carolina Federation of Women since 1964, and a member of the North Carolina Republican Party Executive and Central Committees since 1970. She is on the Board of Directors for the American Red Cross and the YMCA for Greensboro, North Carolina. In 2006, Ms. Shaw was appointed to the Presidential Scholars Commission.
